

Reading Graphic Organizer: Sixth Grade

1. Column One: Complete the first column of the graphic organizer (chart), listing at least **8** things you already know about the book. If you are not familiar with it, these could be as basic as the title, author, cover design, number of pages, and so forth.

2. Column Two: Ask questions during your reading and list those in the second column. Would you like to know why characters act the way they do or what they might be thinking? Do you wonder what might happen next? (Be **specific** and include at least **8** questions throughout your reading process.)

3. Column Three: After you have finished the novel, write at least **8** comments about how your knowledge has changed. Were any of your questions from column two answered? Were there any surprises in the story? Be brief but as specific as possible.
